LOGOS


PRIMARY LOGO

- Preferred logo for the "first look" of any communication (headers, social media, invoices, etc.)
- Showcases the signature Mastery Logistics "Copper" color as well as Omaha Mastery AAA Hockey Association, Inc.'s most impactful font ("Primetime")




ALTERNATE LOGO

- Alternative to use when the Primary Logo doesn't fit the "feel" of the composition or if simplified representation is preferred (e.g. secondary headers, footers, bullet points, etc.)
- Use in black, copper, or white from the color palette
- For the **WHITE** logo: A thin <u>black</u> or <u>copper</u> outline can be used for visibility on a lighter background, but if the logo is placed on a darker background, the outline shouldn't be used unless absolutely necessary



SECONDARY ALTERNATE LOGO

 Same guidelines from the [above] Alternate Logo apply, but use either of these two options (dark gray and light gray <u>from the color palette</u>) when black, white, or copper don't fit the composition or "feel" of the moment

A subtle drop shadow can be added to the logos for more impact if it fits the narrative of the moment

TYPOGRAPHY

DIN CONDENSED

DIN Condensed is our most versatile typeface, and it's mainly used for body copy (like you're reading right now). It can be **bolded**, <u>underlined</u> or *italisized* for emphasis, and it's also used as a secondary option for typography in headers, footers, social media, etc.

PRIMETIME

Primetime is used to catch the eye and make a **statement**. It's featured in our primary logo, and it's ideal for text that doesn't feature a ton of words and/or letters (e.g. paragraph headers). It can be **bolded**, but it can look "crowded" if bolded in the wrong situation. We also occasionally <u>underline</u> the Primetime font for emphasis, but because it's so clean and bold on its own, it usually doesn't need any special touches.

BEBAS NEUE

Bebas Neue combines the best of both worlds between DIN Condensed and Primetime. It's clean and narrow (like DIN Condensed), but as an all-caps font (like Primetime), it provides a nice emphasis for certain moments. With that in mind, we use it to supplement the Primetime font in document headers, but it can also be utilized as a paragraph header within body text. Additionally, similar to DIN Condensed and Primetime (for our purposes), it can be <u>underlined</u> for emphasis, The type family also offers two different boldface styles as well as a thin style (see right).

It doesn't happen often, but we'll incorporate custom modifications to these typefaces where a "crafty touch" is needed (e.g. adjust tracking, line spacing, etc. from the standard).

TYPOGRAPHY × SOCIAL MEDIA

DIN Condensed, Primetime and Bebas Neue are to be used on our social channels for the same purposes illustrated on the previous page, but our social channels allow freedom to use additional fonts (as needed) that may be trending in the social world at that time or may be more "eye-catching" than what one may expect to see on a document with a lot of copy.

GLOSS AND BLOOM
